

distance. For two penalty strokes the player may take relief by dropping a ball in this relief area (see Rule 14.3).

Two estimated reference points (a) Ball reference point; the point where the original ball is estimated to have come to rest on the course or where it last crossed the course boundary to go out of bounds. (b) Fairway reference point; the point of fairway of the hole being played that is nearest the ball reference point, but not nearer the hole than the ball reference point. For the purpose of this Local Rule "fairway" means any area of grass in the General Area that is cut to fairway height or less. This may be a grass path or teeing ground.

Size of relief area is based on the reference points, and is anywhere between (a) a line from the hole through the ball reference point and within two clublengths outside that line, and (b) a line from the hole through the fairway reference point and within two clublengths to the fairway side of that line. It also has these limits; must be in the General Area and must not be nearer the hole than the ball reference point.

Once the player puts a ball into play under this Local Rule, the original ball is no longer in play, even if it is found within the three minute search time (see Rule 6.3b).

This alternative may not be used if (a) the original ball is known or virtually certain to have come to rest in a Penalty Area or (b) the player has played another ball provisionally under Rule 18.3.

The player may use this option to take relief for a Provisional Ball that has not been found or is known or virtually certain to be out of bounds.

7 SUSPENSION OF PLAY (Rule 5.7 Applies).

A long horn blast signals immediate suspension, a series of short horn blasts signals normal suspension.

A long horn blast signals resumption of play.

8 The Bay Of Islands Golf Club Kerikeri Pace of Play Policy is a Local Rule.

9 The Bay Of Islands Golf Club Kerikeri Code of Conduct Policy is a Local Rule.

10 Official Time for the club is as displayed by Vodafone/Spark.

Penalty for breach of Local Rules: General Penalty.

Green Staff have compulsory right of way. Any breach of this rule may result in disqualification and/or notification under rule 22 of the Club Rules.

Fairway Markers. Distances to the centre of the green

Blue - 180 metres, White - 135 metres, Red - 90 metres
